## COMMANDS FROM THE SYSTEM PROMPT

To use the following commands, your DOS path should include the WordStar directory. If it doesn't, you need to log on to that directory.

COMMAND	DESCRIPTION
WS	Starts WordStar and goes to the Opening Menu.
ws filename	Starts WordStar and opens the file <i>filename</i> in document mode unless the default has been changed to nondocument.
ws filename/n	Starts WordStar and opens the file filename in nondocument mode.
ws filename/d	Starts WordStar and opens the file filename in document mode.
ws filename/s	Starts WordStar and opens a new file with no filename.
ws filename/p	Starts WordStar and prints the file filename.
ws filename/x	Starts WordStar, opens the file, and exits WordStar upon returning to the Opening screen. (Use x with another option; see next example.)
ws filename/p/x	Starts WordStar, prints the file filename, and exits to DOS.
ws filename/o nnn	Starts WordStar, opens the file, and goes to the decimal location nnn.
ws filename/hn	Starts WordStar, opens the file, and sets the help level at n.
ws filename/m macroname	Executes the named macro from inside the file filename.
ws /m macroname	Plays the named macro from the Opening screen.
